

The Institute for International Education annual Open Doors report, which tracks US students studying abroad as well as international students coming to the US, has provided new data for 2006-2007 which highlights SDSU's successes:

1. For the third year in a row, SDSU **was ranked #1** in California in our Carnegie Classification (Research University/High Activity).
2. SDSU **ranked # 2 nationally** for study abroad in our Carnegie Classification. This is also the third year in a row for this ranking. The first ranked is Brigham Young University.
3. For **ALL** universities **nationally**, including those in the highest Carnegie Classification (Research University/Very High Activity), SDSU **ranked # 21** for study abroad, up from 23 last year.
4. SDSU **ranked # 13 nationally** for mid-length study abroad duration for **ALL** categories.
5. According to the National Clearinghouse on Disability and Exchange Mobility International, SDSU was **ranked # 2** in the nation for sending students abroad with disabilities. First ranked was Purdue.

These rankings show that SDSU continues to be in the forefront in the area of international education.
